We will still be accepting new clients from the public, but only after they have been approved by the entire SE Staff. This means that there will be an application process that will include filling out an application followed by an interview.

We love to get paid for our hard work, especially the really creative stuff that we do, but flashing \$100 bills isn't going to get you into SE any quicker.

We are an exclusive recording club, interested in finding amazing talent and then recording and producing them in our studio.

We have found from working with people in the entertainment business for the past 20-years, that we need to be more selective who we let through the door. It is nothing personal, it is purely a business decision.

- If you are always drunk and/or obnoxious, you will not be welcome at SE Studios. (Sorry)
- If you come to SE Studios and destroy equipment (accidentally or purposefully) and show no regard for other people's belongings, you will be banned from SE Studios for life and be required to reimburse the studio for any and all damages that were incurred during the incident.
- If you show up at SE Studios un-announced, we probably won't answer the door for you. We really appreciate when people call first and ask if we need anything at the studio. Big ups to our partners! If you have a problem with that, then SE might not be the right place for you.

We are very serious about creating music and videos and we know the difference between people who are and people who are not.

We would love to serve the entire community but unfortunately we are only able to focus on multiple large projects at one time.

if you were to apply now, especially if you are serious about your project. After we receive your application we will listen to your demo and verify your references, then call you and set up a time for an in-studio interview.

After meeting with you in person and assessing your project needs, we will speak with our partners and decide whether or not your project meets the criteria we are looking for. If it does, then we will call you and set up a first-time recording session.

At that point, you will be required to make a 50% deposit and sign a Production Agreement with SE Studios and Progressive Edge Records.

No media will leave the studio until the balance is paid in full.

There are no exceptions to this rule.

We would love to be able to help every person and give them a “bro deal”, but the truth is that we are very good at what we do and we take music and video production very seriously, so please be straight up with us and pay your bills.

If at any point you deem it necessary to blackmail, bully, threaten or attempt to extort money or services from SE Studios or its staff, your project will be terminated immediately and you will receive no refund whatsoever.

At that point, criminal charges may be filed against you for these wrong doings.
